

## **GREATER HANSVILLE COMMUNITY CENTER ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION**

The Greater Hansville Community Center is currently offering one or more scholarships to high school seniors or graduates who wish to pursue an undergraduate degree or technical school certificate program. Selection will be based on the applicant's academic performance (e.g. grades, test scores, coursework), financial need, letters of recommendation, community involvement, and quality of the application materials.

### **Awards**

Awards will be granted for tuition, books, and fees. Monies will be sent directly to the school of attendance early in the next academic year. Any change in the school attended will result in re-evaluation of the scholarship application and monies granted.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

To be considered for a scholarship, an applicant must:

1. Be a high school graduate as of June of the year of application or have graduated within the past 5 years.
2. Have not yet earned an undergraduate (bachelors) degree at any institution.
3. Show good academic standing in high school or in post high school undergraduate studies.
4. Show qualities of character, citizenship and self-reliance.
5. Be a resident of the Greater Hansville Area defined as the area of North Kitsap that lies north of Delaney Road on the east side of Hansville Road and north of Little Boston/Cliffside Drive on the west side of Hansville Road.

### **Scholarship Application Process**

1. Complete the application in its entirety.
2. Include the following documentation with your signed application:
  - a. Official transcript showing courses and grades or most recent schooling.
  - b. SAT or ACT scores.
  - c. Two original, current letters of recommendation from persons qualified to testify regarding your character, reliability, scholarship, and capability.
3. Mail a packet of all materials, postmarked on or before March 15<sup>th</sup> to:

4. In the event that an interview is needed, you will be contacted at the phone or e-mail address listed on your application.

### **Scholarship Award Presentation**

The scholarship committee will contact recipients following selection via letter no later than May 15<sup>th</sup>. Recipients will be announced and introduced at the May luncheon meeting of the Hansville Neighbors. Scholarships to graduating high school students will also be announced at the annual high school awards night in early June.
