#### **Awards**

Any change in the school attended will result in re-evaluation of the scholarship application and monies granted. There is no official due date for applications, and they may be submitted through out the year. Awards will be considered at the time of the receipt of the application and based on funds available. #### **Eligibility Requirements**

To be considered, an applicant must:

- Have a plan for working toward a degree, certification, or continuing education credit.
  
- Be a resident of the Greater Hansville Area defined as the area of North Kitsap that lies north of Delaney Road on the east side of Hansville Road and north of Little Boston/Cliffside Drive on the west side of Hansville Road.

#### **Scholarship Application Process**

1. Complete the application in its entirety.
  
2. If you graduated from high school in the past 5 years and did not attend college, include an official transcript showing high school courses. If you graduated from high school in the past 5 years and did have some college courses, include an official transcript of the college courses in addition to the high school transcript.
